



Seeds of Hope International Partnerships (SHIP), a Christian community development organization, began working in Zambia in 2003.

Interventions since 2003:



- ✚ Shipped four drill rigs to Zambia
- ✚ Provided safe water to over 250,000 people
- ✚ Drilled and overseen drilling of 98 new wells
- ✚ Repaired over 242 broken hand pumps
- ✚ Built and installed over 1,850 biosand filters
- ✚ Helped rural communities to build over 198 latrines in schools and villages
- ✚ Trained 4,500 people in Participatory Hygiene classes in 250 villages
- ✚ Equipped over 95 people with increased vocational or agricultural skills.

Working through Zambian nationals, *SHIP* is pioneering a replicable model for holistic Community Development Resource Centers built on Biblical principles and values. Our vision is that the Resource Centers will have a multipliable impact and that the concept will be adopted and replicated throughout all of Zambia and into other countries in Africa.



Program Areas:

- ✚ IWASHE – Integrated Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene Education
- ✚ Well Drilling and Hand Pump Repair
- ✚ Participatory Hygiene, Sanitation, and HIV/AIDS Education
- ✚ Improved Agriculture Techniques
- ✚ Literacy and Vocational Training

By providing safe water, hygiene training, sanitation promotion, and biosand water filter promotion and production, *SHIP* is bringing **improved health** to people living in Zambia. Through improved agriculture techniques and vocational and literacy training, we are **bringing hope for a better future.**



Projected outputs for 2009 (dependent on funding levels):

- ✚ Drill 84 new boreholes and repair 105 broken hand pumps
- ✚ Install 1,200 Sand Filters
- ✚ Conduct 72 multi-day school or village level hygiene trainings
- ✚ Promote sanitation in 15 communities through demonstration latrines
- ✚ Introduce improved agriculture techniques to impoverished farmers
- ✚ Open a Resource Center in Zimbabwe

These outputs will result in saving lives by bringing clean water to over 130,000 people. Together with our funding partners, *SHIP* is planting seeds for spiritual and economic transformation in Zambia by providing training in holistic community development based on Biblical principles. Through providing safe water and expanding vocational opportunities we will enable people to begin to reverse the downward spiral of poverty and provide hope for improved health and a better future.
